The ASK program provides educational resources and scholarships to youth who take part in HPARD programs. Since 2000, more than \$85,000 has been given to youth ages 13 to 19 for scholarships, tutoring and practice exams, college and career fairs, and college tours. Proceeds from the Father's Day Father/Child Charity Golf Tournament support the ASK education fund and educational activities.



HOUSTON PARKS BOARD

The Houston Parks Board, a charitable, 501 (c) (3) nonprofit organization, initiated the creation and fundraising campaign for The First Tee of Houston at F.M. Law Park. The \$1.4 million facility includes nine holes, an 80-station lighted driving range, and an indoor learning center. Proceeds from the Father/Child Charity Golf Tournament were used to light the putting and chipping greens, build a maintenance storage facility, add a new short game area, and upgrade the course irrigation system.
